The yarn is produced using both post-consumer waste and post production fiber waste. Behind every mound of post-consumer waste is a mountain of pre-consumer waste. The waste by products are generated in the US.

How does recycled yarn help conserve natural resources?

The recycled yarn process reclaims valuable renewable resources from the waste stream and converts them into something useful. It takes less energy resources to produce than if starting over from scratch. On average, one pound of recycled yarn conserves the equivalent of 1/2 gallons of gasoline.

How is Eco Friendly beneficial to the Transit and Motor Coach market?

Eco Friendly fabric is an every day reminder that the user is sensitive to the environment and sustainability.
