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Tools needed









Safety Goggles

Diagnol Cutter pliers & Long nose pliers <u>Flat Head</u> <u>Screwdriver</u>

<u>Kit P# SUB107914 –</u> <u>Replacement Parts</u>



Field Service – Knob detached from Mechanism





Instructions





Step 2:

Use side cutter pliers to hold the tab and roll the retainer clip over the spindle.



Step 3:

Use a flathead screwdriver, if needed, to pry off the retainer clip.



Replacement Kit







Place Recliner Knob over Spindle Plate. (Pointed features must match when Knob is assembled to Spindle Plate)

Step 4:

Knob assembled on Spindle Plate



Step 5:

Slightly rotate Knob left and right to ensure Knob is positioned properly






Step 6: Place Retaining Disk to Knob



Step 7:

Three notches on Retaining Disk to match with three protrusions on Knob





Step 8: Slide E-Clip under Spindle Head with the flathead screwdriver. Recliner Knob not shown for visual purpose




Note! Retaining Plate needs to be pushed down for *E-Clip to slide under the groove.*

Ensure E-Clip's proper placement under the groove by gently pull Knob outboard.

Step 9:

Rotate Knob left and right for proper function.

Step 10:

Assemble Recliner Knob cover

Knob is replaced
